RULES TO REGULATE THE USES OF SPRING LAKE IN THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY

- Rule 1. Waterskiing is prohibited.
- Rule 2. Only electrically powered motors shall be used to power boats.
- Rule 3. A person operating a power boat shall not exceed a speed limit of 5 m.p.h.
- Rule 4. Except as may be authorized by the Vermont Aeronautics Board, no aircraft shall land on, or take off from, Spring Lake except under emergency conditions.
- Rule 5. Docks or floats, whether removable or permanent, shall be constructed of non-polluting material.
- Rule 6. No houseboats, or boats with living facilities, are permitted.
- Rule 7. Boats owned or operated by agencies of the State of Vermont shall comply insofar as possible with the rules promulgated herein by the Vermont Water Resources Board, except in cases of law enforcement, emergencies, or the performance of official duties.
- Rule 8. These rules supplement, and are not intended to modify, other applicable laws and regulations, except as provided herein.
- Rule 9. To the extent they have authority to do so, the Selectmen of the Town of Shrewsbury may make Ordinances to amplify or enforce these rules, in a manner consistent with them, as the public interest of all the citizens of the State may warrant.
- Rule 10. The Vermont Water Resources Board retains jurisdiction over the subject matter of these rules and may modify them in accordance with applicable Statutes.
