


RULES TO REGULATE THE USES OF GLEN LAKE  
IN THE TOWNS OF CASTLETON, FAIR HAVEN AND BENSON

1. No boat powered by motor shall be operated anywhere on Glen Lake at speeds in excess of five (5) miles per hour.
2. No houseboats or boats with living facilities are permitted on Glen Lake at any time.
3. All power boats shall be operated in strict conformance with Title 25, Chapter 5 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated, dealing with water safety and the use of motorboats (for details consult pamphlet put out by the Department of Public Safety).
4. Boats owned or operated by Agencies of the State of Vermont shall comply insofar as possible with the rules promulgated herein by the Vermont Water Resources Board, except in cases of law enforcement, emergencies or the performance of official duties.
5. These rules supplement and are not intended to modify other applicable laws and regulations other than as provided herein.
6. The Vermont Water Resources Board retains jurisdiction over the subject matter of these rules and may modify them in accordance with applicable statutes.
