RULES REGULATING THE USE OF
INDIAN BROOK RESERVOIR
TOWN OF ESSEX

- RULE 1: The operation of vessels powered by internal combustion motors is prohibited.
- RULE 2: Except in an emergency situation or as authorized by the Vermont Transportation Board in accordance with 5 V.S.A. Chapter 9, aircraft are prohibited from landing or taking off from Indian Brook Reservoir.
- RULE 3: Vessels operated by agencies of the State of Vermont shall comply with Rules 1 and 2 at all times, except in cases where law enforcement, emergencies or performance of official duties requires otherwise.

At its meeting on March 31, 1989 the Water Resources Board adopted the following rules:

Rule 1: The operation of vessels powered by internal combustion motors is prohibited.

Rule 2: Except in an emergency situation or as authorized by the Vermont Transportation Board in accordance with 5 V.S.A. Chapter 9, aircraft are prohibited from landing or taking off from Indian Brook Reservoir.

Rule 3: Vessels operated by agencies of the State of Vermont shall comply with Rules 1 and 2 at all times, except in cases where law enforcement, emergencies or performance of official duties requires otherwise.

These rules will become effective April 20, 1989. Posters regarding these rules are being published. I will send copies to the Town as soon as they are available.
