RE: Final Changes to Caspian Lake Rules for the Use of Public Waters

In the course of being reviewed by the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules, the final step in the rulemaking process, a couple of changes to the Board's final proposed rules were made as outlined below.

Caspian Lake

1. On page one of its decision dated November 20, 1991, the Board listed the four rules to be adopted. Rule #2 regarding the night time speed limit contains a typographical error and is actually in effect "between one half hour after sunset and one half hour before sunrise." This time frame was established to be consistent with other rules currently enforced under the Vermont boating regulations. Therefore, the Rule was corrected as follows:

2. Vessels powered by motor shall not exceed a speed of 10 m.p.h. between one half hour after sunset and one half hour before sunrise.

2. Also on page one of the Board's November 20, 1991, decision, under Rule #4(a)(2), there is a typographical error regarding the number of buoys permitted in a ski slalom course. The number "10" should actually read "16", and therefore, the Rule was corrected as follows:

4(a)(2). "There shall be no more than 16 buoys providing for more than four slalom turns."
