The Watershed Management Division of the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation (the Department) received a petition from the **Shadow Lake Association**, per Subsection 4.1(d) of the **Vermont Use of Public Water Rules**, to establish a one (1) acre temporary no boating or swimming zone to minimize the spread of the aquatic nuisance species Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*) in Shadow Lake, in the Town of Glover.
