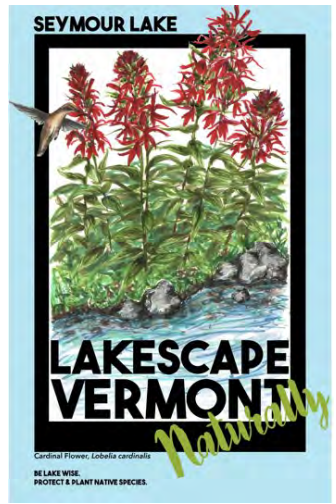


# Lakescape Vermont Naturally

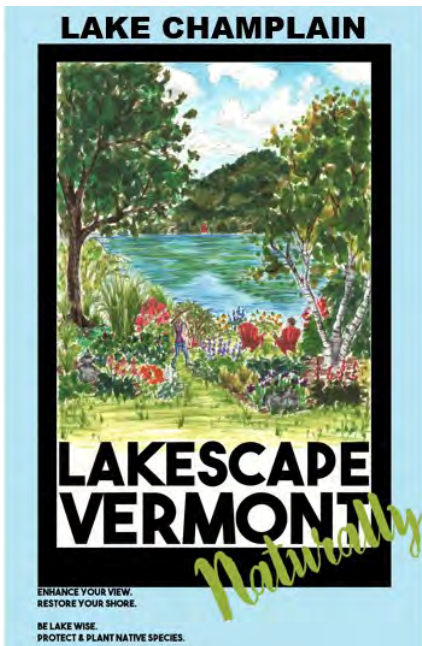
## Poster Series

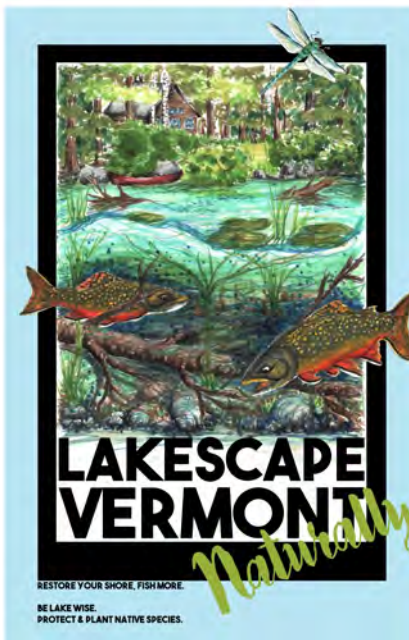

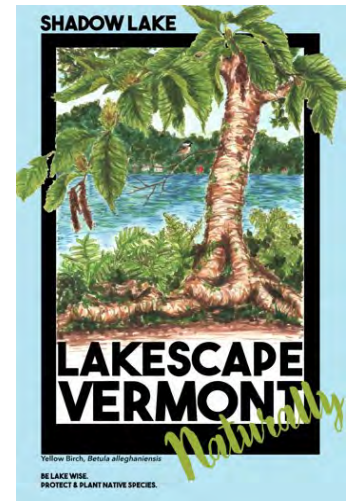
Cardinal Flower

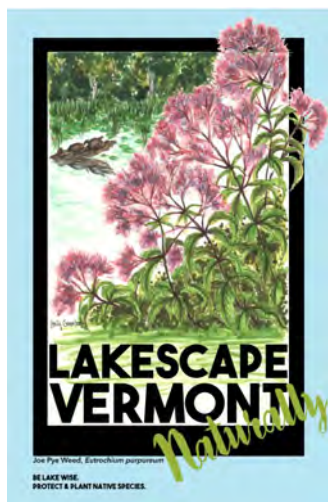
Lakescape Vermont

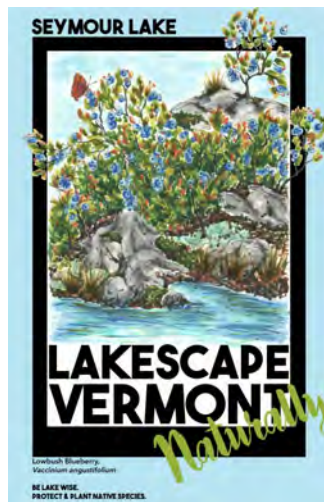
Lakescape World

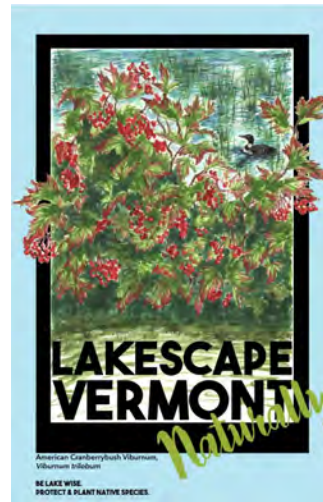
Yellow Birch

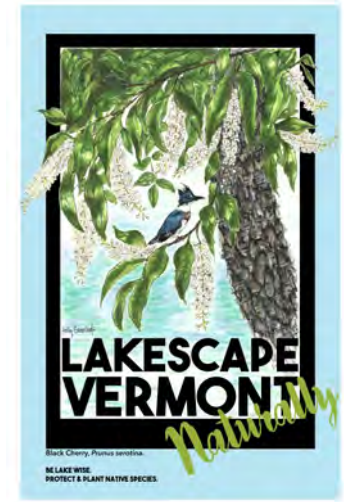
