

# Guidance for Lake Champlain Marinas to Locate Cleaning Solutions and PPE

CONNECTING SCIENCE TO COMMUNITIES IN THE LAKE CHAMPLAIN BASIN

## INTRODUCTION

As COVID-19 stay at home measures are eased in Vermont and New York, Lake Champlain marinas that can conduct their work following strict social distancing measures will also be required to follow a variety of disinfecting and cleaning procedures to ensure the safety of their staff. Both the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA) have developed guidance for businesses to help in this planning process:

As disinfectants, cleaning products, and personal protective equipment are in high demand, this document was developed to share resources to aid marinas (and other businesses) in identifying local sources of sanitizing and cleaning solutions, as well as face mask distributors. Listing in this document does not imply support for or guarantee of services or products.

## RECOMMENDED DISINFECTANT PRODUCTS

The Environmental Protection Agency developed a [searchable list of disinfectant products that can be used against SARS-CoV2](#), which is the virus that causes COVID-19. Among other information, the list details the product name, active ingredient, and type of surface and required contact time to be effective against this virus. All disinfectant products listed are for use on objects, not people, and directions on each product should be followed to ensure safe use.

## CDC Guidance and Cleaning

The CDC has [guidance available for how to clean and disinfect a variety of surfaces](#).

Employees will need access to a variety of safety and cleaning supplies, including soap or hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol, disinfecting chemicals (e.g., bleach), disposable gloves, cloth masks, and paper towels.
