RE: Lake Association Registration

With the 2020 field season rapidly approaching, we invite you to register your lake association with the Agency of Natural Resources (ANR).

WHY? Recent legislation requires a lake association to be registered for the following purposes:

- 1) **To establish an approved aquatic nuisance species inspection station**, the authority of which is stated in 10 V.S.A. § 1454(c):
 - No-cost boat wash; aquatic nuisance species inspection station. It shall be a violation of this section for a person transporting a vessel to or from a water to not have the vessel, the motor vehicle transporting the vessel, the trailer, and other equipment inspected and decontaminated at an approved aquatic nuisance species inspection station prior to launching the vessel and upon leaving a water if:
 - a) an aquatic nuisance species inspection station is maintained at the area where the vessel is entering or leaving the water;
 - b) the aquatic nuisance species inspection station is open; and
 - c) an individual operating the aquatic nuisance species inspection station identifies the vessel for inspection or decontamination.
- 2) To conduct rapid response or aquatic nuisance control activities as a lake association under the Aquatic Nuisance Control General Permit (the permit is available at https://dec.vermont.gov/watershed/lakes-ponds/permit/control/aquatic-nuisance-control/ANCGP).

HOW? To register with ANR, complete the attached registration form. There is no fee associated with this application. Completed application forms can be submitted via email to ANR.WSMDLakes@vermont.gov or to the mailing address listed on the application.

A lake association must be registered with the Secretary of the Agency of Natural Resources to either establish an aquatic nuisance species watercraft inspection decontamination stations (10 V.S.A. § 1461) or to apply for Aquatic Nuisance Control General Permit coverage to conduct nonchemical aquatic nuisance control activities for an aquatic nuisance or nonchemical rapid response control activities for nonindigenous new aquatic species (10 V.S.A. § 1455). Submission of this application indicates that a lake association intends to be a registered lake association as defined in 10 V.S.A. § 1452. All information required on this form must be provided.

Lake associations need only register once, but contacts may be asked to update information and other pertinent details as necessary.
