





Greensboro Town Plan and Zoning to support Reclassification of Caspian Lake

Greensboro adopted its first zoning by-laws in December of 1972 and the most recent update was recorded in March of 2015. The Town has an active Planning Commission which advises and suggests updates to the zoning by-laws.

Greensboro was founded in 1781 and the perimeter of the Caspian Lake was originally settled as a farming community. The farmers later sold lots to summer camp residents. The history of settlement and subsequent camp establishments have formed the land-use pattern that still exists in the Caspian Lake watershed. Most of the lake shore has been developed and there is still a large presence of farming, especially haying in the surrounding landscape.

The zoning by-laws reflect the need to preserve both lake front vegetation and to reduce run-off from adjacent lands. In the most recent zoning by-law amendment of March 2015, lake buffer widths were increased and more restrictions were placed on vegetation management in the buffers. The Planning Commission is currently reviewing and proposing new buffer widths and the activities that will be allowed in stream side buffers in Greensboro.

Greensboro zoning by-laws reflect the Town's desire to protect water quality. Reclassification of Caspian Lake will not change the by-laws, but it may bring changes to peoples perspective of the Lake's water quality and how it can be protected.

Following are some relevant excerpts from the Greensboro Town Plan

COMMUNITY PROFILE

As Greensboro transitions from a resources-based economy to a tourist-based economy, it is imperative to create a Town Plan that honors and respects Greensboro's relationship with the natural environment. A healthy natural environment is critical to meeting many goals of the Plan, and a major objective is the protection and preservation of all Greensboro's waters, including lakes, ponds, streams, rivers, groundwater, wetlands, floodwater absorption areas, sources of water supply, habitats, and recreation areas.

Looking forward, the Town will be increasingly challenged to make decisions that honor the stewardship of the rich history of the healthy, natural world that has shaped this community. In light of development pressures, it may be a difficult balance to preserve what is precious about Greensboro. Stewardship of the health of the lake and maintenance of the rural character of the community are integral to Greensboro's sense of identity.

TOWN WIDE SURVEY RESPONSES

Then the survey asked, "What I never want to change in Greensboro". The top four responses were:

- Lake Water Quality
- Willey's and Other Establishments
- Rural Character
- Open Space

A VISION FOR GREENSBORO

Greensboro residents aspire to see a future for the community where:

- The Town's rural character is viewed as a significant benefit that should be preserved

- As a community, there is a strong sense that conservation of our natural resources, including Caspian Lake, should be a high priority

NATURAL RESOURCES GOAL, POLICIES & ACTIONS

Stewardship with integrity over all of Greensboro's natural resources, including open fields, forests, animal and plant habitats, streams, lakes, and scenic landscape in a manner that protects and enhances the town's ecological health and biological diversity for the benefit of current and future residents.

Policies

Establish conservation priorities that will preserve agricultural land, evergreen and deciduous forests, important wildlife habitat, water resources, river corridors, wetlands, stream and lake shorelines and scenic view sheds.

Protect the water quality of the Town's lakes, streams, and watersheds against degradation by pollution, runoff and erosion.

Investigate paths to improving wastewater systems in the Village and in the Bend, which will serve to improve water quality in our streams and lakes

Preserve Caspian Lake shoreline and ridgeline view sheds from any further development.

Support the continuation and expansion of the State of Vermont Current Use Program, administered by the Division of Property Valuation and Review, Department of Taxes, to tax farm and forest properties at their productive value rather than their development potential. Encourage the participation of Greensboro property owners in that program.

Develop policies to protect Greensboro's groundwater by regulating the construction of new or expanded commercial, agricultural or industrial activities that extract and sell groundwater, and ensure that proper reclamation plans are created for earth extraction operations.

Actions

1) Inventory and map the natural resources in Greensboro, including contiguous forest habitats, to create a map of "Areas of High Public Value" that will provide a guide for future land conservation efforts.

2) Preserve lake water quality.

A) Request that the Greensboro Land Trust/Conservation Commission update the Caspian Lake Feeder Stream Study conducted in 2013 and suggest specific actions and Bylaw changes to improve lake water quality. Apply for a grant from VDEC.

B) Request that the Conservation Commission evaluate further actions needed and Bylaws amendments required to protect lake water quality from all potentially harmful actions on Caspian Lake.

C) Amend the Town Bylaws to create a 100 foot buffer along streams.

D) Work with the Greensboro Road Department and others, including farmers, landowners and Greensboro Association members, to identify further actions that will control stormwater runoff (utilize the 2017 Greensboro Stormwater Study) into Caspian Lake. These actions may require change to the Town Bylaws.

E) Amend the Town Bylaws to minimize runoff impacts from development on steep slopes. Require extraordinary stormwater controls for development of slopes of 15- 25% and prohibit development on slopes greater than 25%.

3) Conduct public outreach to a) educate shore land property owners in order to reverse the negative trend in shore land vegetation and aquatic habitat; b) to implement best management practices consistent with the Vermont LakeWise program; c) to control milfoil and other aquatic nuisances, and d) educate property owners adjacent to the lake to keep their septic systems properly maintained.

4) Work with the State of Vermont to evaluate the best water level of Caspian Lake to be maintained in order to have the least amount of impact on aquatic habitat and to protect lakeshore habitat.







I am writing on behalf of the Vermont chapter of Native Fish Coalition in support of the petition to reclassify the water quality rating of Caspian Lake in Greensboro to A(1) status.

Native Fish Coalition (NFC) is a nonpartisan, grassroots, donor-funded, all volunteer, 501(c)(3) national non-profit organization dedicated to the conservation, preservation, and restoration of wild native fish. We currently have state chapters in Alabama, Connecticut, Georgia, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Pennsylvania, Vermont and West Virginia representing members, partners, volunteers, supporters and followers.

Decades of data have documented declining water quality in Caspian Lake, from its historic cold and clear oligotrophic status to mesotrophic caused by higher nutrient loads. Spring phosphorous readings have nearly doubled between 1980 and 2019; summer readings grew at a similar pace between 1994 and 2021. Samplings of Caspian's major tributaries (Porter, Tate, Cemetery Brooks) and minor tributaries show elevated phosphorus levels (c.20 ppm) with certain readings many times that level.

NFC understands this reclassification is sought under "aesthetics," as defined in Vermont Water Quality Standards. There may be grounds for an improved rating under fishery habitat as well, given the population of wild native lake trout in Caspian.

There is significant local support for the petition. The Stewards of Greensboro Watersheds collected 400 signatures in support. The five-member select board voted in favor of the petition in September 2021.

Vermont's water quality standards, revised in 2017, state "All waters shall be managed to protect, maintain, and improve water quality" (VT Water Quality Standards, § 29A-105, 2017). At this time, the state's anti-degradation policy compels the Agency of Natural Resources to pursue rulemaking to reclassify Caspian Lake to an A(1) rating.

Clean water is vital to Vermont's future. This reclassification will help focus resources to identify and resolve point and non-point sources of phosphorus pollution in the Caspian Lake watershed.
