

Public Comment Notice

2022 State Priority Waters Lists, including Part A (303(d) List of Impaired Waters)

The Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation is making available for public comment the draft 2022 List of Priority Waters which includes the draft 303(d) List of Impaired Waters. **The deadline for comment submittal has been extended from May 20, 2022, to June 3, 2022.** Copies of the draft documents can be obtained by downloading from the Watershed Management Division [website](#).

The draft 2022 303(d) List of Impaired Waters consists of the following:

- Part A - impaired waters scheduled for TMDL development.

The draft 2022 List of Priority Waters consists of the following:

- Part B - impaired waters which do not need a TMDL.
- Part D – impaired waters for which TMDLs have been completed and approved by EPA.
- Part E - waters altered by aquatic invasive species.
- Part F - waters altered by flow regulation.
