



Notice of Intent (NOI) for Stormwater Discharges

Associated with Construction Activities on **LOW RISK SITES**Under Vermont Construction General Permit 3-9020

Submission of this completed Notice of Intent (NOI) constitutes notice that the entities in Section A intend to be authorized to discharge pollutants to Waters of the State, from the project identified in Section 3, under Vermont's Construction General Permit (CGP). Submission of the NOI constitutes notice that the parties identified in Section 1 of this form have read, understand, and meet the eligibility conditions of the CGP; have determined that the project qualifies for coverage as a Low Risk project in conformance with Appendix A of the CGP; agree to comply with all applicable terms and conditions of the CGP; understand that continued authorization under the CGP is contingent on maintaining eligibility for coverage; and that all applicable practices in the Low Risk Site Handbook for Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control must be implemented and maintained for the duration of construction activities. In order to be granted coverage, all information required on this form must be provided and an application fee payable to the State of Vermont must be submitted.

APPEALS

Renewable Energy Projects – Right to Appeal to Public Service Board

If this decision relates to a renewable energy plant for which a certificate of public good is required under 30 V.S.A. §248, any appeal of this decision must be filed with the Vermont Public Service Board pursuant to 10 V.S.A. §8506. This section does not apply to a facility that is subject to 10 V.S.A. §1004 (dams before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission), 10 V.S.A. §1006 (certification of hydroelectric projects) or 10 V.S.A. Chapter 43 (dams). Any appeal under this section must be filed with the clerk

of the Public Service Board within 30 days of the date of this decision. For further information, see the Public Service Board within 30 days of the date of this decision. All Other Projects – Right to Appeal to Environmental Court

Pursuant to 10 V.S.A. Chapter 220, any appeal of this decision must be filed with the clerk of the Environmental Court within 30 days of the date of the decision. The Notice of Appeal must specify the parties taking the appeal and the statutory provision under which each party claims party status; must designate the act or decision appealed from; must name the Environmental Court; and must be signed by the appellant or their attorney. In addition, the appeal must give the address or location and description of the property, project or facility with which the appeal is concerned and the name of the applicant or any permit involved in the appeal. The appellant must also serve a copy of the Notice of Appeal in accordance with Rule 5(b)(4)(B) of the Vermont Rules for Environmental Court Proceedings, available online at www.vermontjudiciary.org or call (802) 951-1740. The address for the Environmental Court is 32 Cherry Street, 2nd Floor Suite 303, Burlington, Vermont 05401.
