Project Description: installation of liner sections and grout between the host pipe and the liner of a culvert. The project also requires the installation of a 100' by 16' temporary access at the inlet portion of the culvert

Wetland Impact: 900sf

Buffer Zone Impact: 800sf

Expiration Date of Authorization: Five years from issuance of authorization.

FURTHER INFORMATION

An application for authorization under Vermont General Wetland Permit (#3-9025), required pursuant to the provisions of Section 9.7 of the Vermont Wetland Rules has been received by the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (VANR). The wetland proposed to be impacted has been designated as a significant (Class II) wetland in the Vermont Wetland Rules. 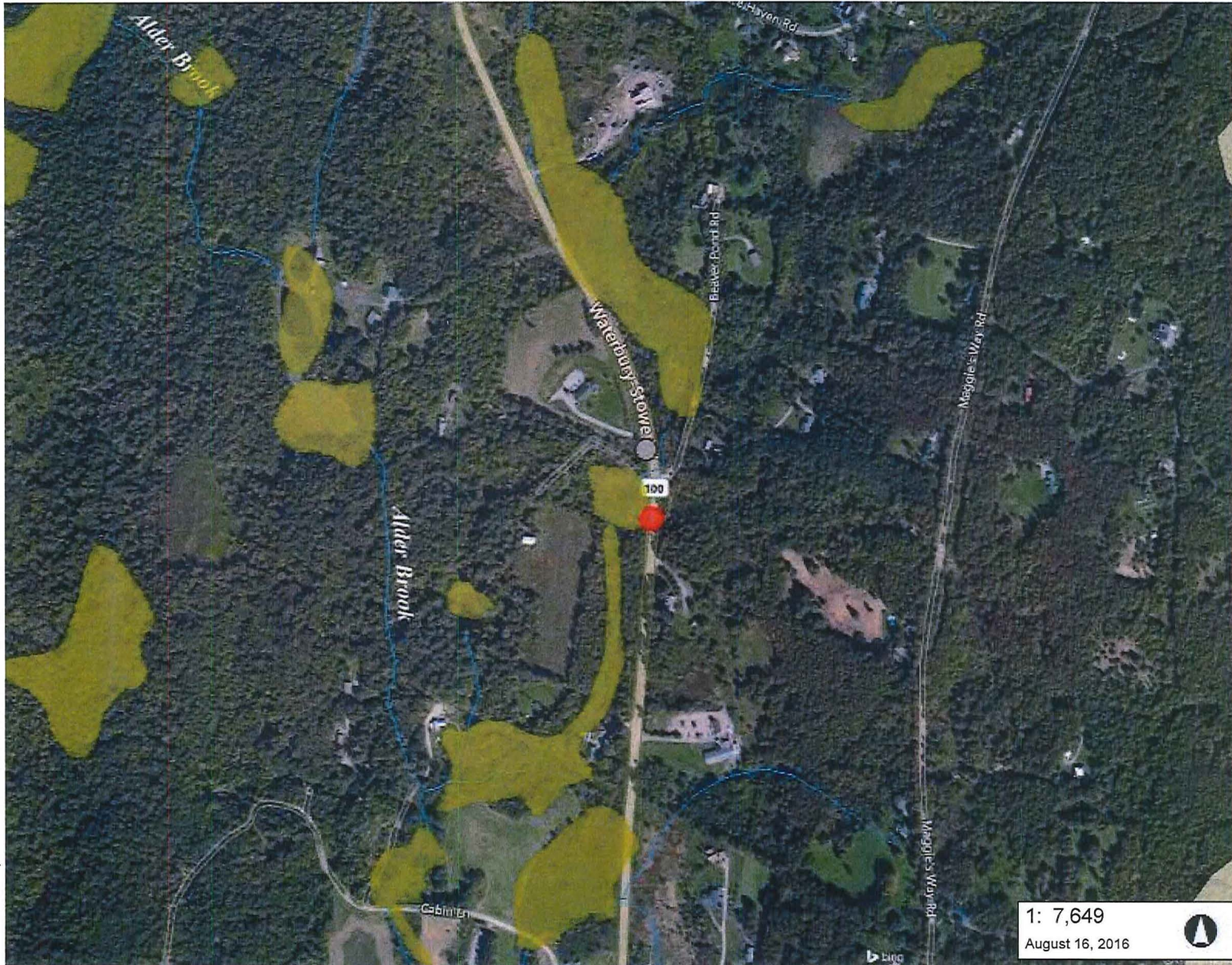
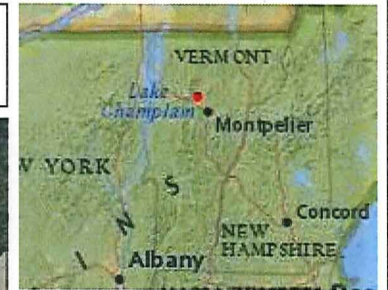
