

DEC Municipal Roads General Permit (MRGP)- Tiered Annual Operating Fees

Summary of methodology used to determine MRGP municipal coverage and fee structure:

- Population data from 2010 Census.
- Municipalities that have operational control over their municipal roads fall under MRGP coverage and will pay applicable fees. Cities, towns, and those incorporated villages with road budgets and/or road crews are deemed applicable municipalities for MRGP coverage. These municipalities are required to annually report to VTrans their individual municipal road mileage by road class. This is mandated by V.S.A. Title 19, Chapter 3, sections 305 and 306
- Municipal population sizes were prorated down since some incorporated villages within these towns separately report annual mileage certificates to VTrans (previous bullet). The populations of those separately reporting villages (in parenthesis below) were subtracted from the town population totals. Prorated municipalities' population include: Bennington (Old Bennington and North Bennington), Manchester (Manchester Village), Lyndon (Lyndonville), Enosburgh (Enosburgh Falls), Swanton (Swanton Village), Newbury (Wells River), Barton (Barton Village and Orleans), Derby (Derby Line), Troy (North Troy), Poultney (Poultney Village), Ludlow (Ludlow Village), and Woodstock (Woodstock). Municipal population and mileage information on separate spreadsheet.
- 9 disincorporated and unorganized towns and gores exempt from MRGP
- 13 MS4 municipalities exempt from MRGP annual operating, administrative, and application fees

Tier 1 Municipalities, \$1,800:

- Municipalities with population greater than 5,000
- Municipalities with 95 or more road miles and population greater than 2,500
