NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT

NOTICE: Public comments are invited on a Draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) general permit for residually designated stormwater discharges to Bartlett, Centennial, Englesby, Morehouse and Potash Brooks. Previously, on June 19, 2009, the Department issued notice of initial designation to property owners with designated stormwater discharges. Comments are invited on both the draft general permit and on whether the designation of any particular stormwater discharge(s) is appropriate.

DESCRIPTION: Pursuant to a Vermont Environmental Court Judgment Order (<u>In re: Stormwater NPDES Petition (Conservation Law Foundation Appeal)</u> Docket No. 14-1-07 Vtec (Aug. 28, 2008)), the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (VTANR) has prepared a NPDES permit for residually designated stormwater discharges to Bartlett, Centennial, Englesby, Morehouse, and Potash Brooks.
