OSPC/EPSC Inspection Report

This form shall be completed by the On-Site Plan Coordinator(OSPC) or a person acting under the direction of the OSPC at least once every 7 calendar days and within 24 hours of the end of a storm event resulting in a discharge of stormwater from the construction site. This form shall also be completed by the EPSC Specialist(*INDCs*) biweekly during earth disturbing activity and not less than once a month during no earth disturbing activities. During winter construction(October 15–April 15) inspections shall be conducted daily during active earthwork. Inspections may be limited to once per month if all areas of the site have temporary or permanent stabilization. All inspection reports shall be retained on site for the duration of the project. Inspections shall cover all areas of the site disturbed by construction activity including areas of temporary stabilization and all discharge locations. Attach additional sheets if more room is needed to complete the report. This report must be retained along with the EPSC Plan for the duration of the project.
