- Walking with your dog

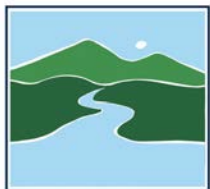


The wetland complex is dominated by softwood swamp community types including, Northern White Cedar Swamps, Black Spruce Swamps and Black Spruce Woodland Bog.

Dennis Pond is a rare type of ecosystem (over 75 acres of a very high-quality Poor Fens) with species not often found in Vermont.



The diversity of habitats in this wetland complex results in heavy use by wildlife, and provides habitat to host a myriad of rare, threatened and endangered plants and insects.



Dennis Pond is a great place to watch birds. There are documented small great blue heron rookery and osprey nests.
