- Swimming



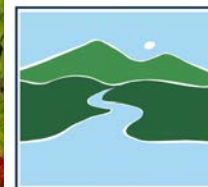
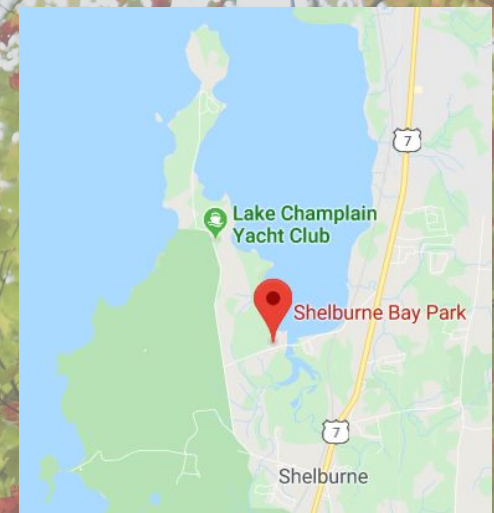
Animal tracks are easy to find in the mud along the riverbank
